## Our role

"If you want to go fast, go alone. If you want to go far, go together", is an african proverb on the wall of the Gates Foundation's office in Seattle. Abundant Ventures focuses on 6 main global goals, one of them is Partnerships for the goals. In a nutshell, this goal wants to unite people in partnerships to work together for a better future. Abundant Ventures does this by partnering up with many enterprises and volunteers to help the B40 community of Malaysia and small holder farmers to have a more sustainable life. An example of this is when we entered a partnership with a small holder farmer named Ashok to plant 1500 rock melon seeds since it was a higher value plant. However, it was his first time doing this, and he was not prepared to take on the risks. Therefore, Abundant Ventures partnered with him to mitigate these risks. I myself was a volunteer on that project along with my friends. At first, the task was backbreaking and ill rewording, only getting a measly amount of work done. However, as more volunteers came to help, the job was done within ample time and we exceeded our goal of 1500 rockmelon seeds. I also learned new things while working on the farm. Did you know about a thing called cocopeat? I certainly didn't. But after working on the farm I learned that it stored large amounts of the water and nutrients, along with being 100% organic and has anti fungal properties. This is the power of partnerships, and as said before, "If you want to go fast, go alone. If you want to go far, go together".
